Sub: **Online submission of Immovable Property Return by IPS officers through— Reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 13.12.2016 (copy available at www.ips.gov.in) on the subject and to say that all IPS officers vide aforesaid letter were requested to file their Immovable Property Return (IPR) for the year 2016 online through SPARROW.

2. However, it has come to notice of this Ministry that some IPS officers have not yet filed their IPR-2016.

3. In view of the above, all State Governments/CAPFS/CPOs are requested to seek explanation of all the IPS officers who have not filed their IPR-2016 online in compliance to the aforesaid instructions and direct them to submit their IPR-2016 online through SPARROW immediately to comply with the provisions of AIS (Conduct) Rules, 1968.

4. It is further clarified that no hard copy of IPR Return or letter regarding intimation of filling IPR online is required to be sent to this Ministry. In case of any difficulty in accessing IPR module through Sparrow the officer may send their grievances through e-mail at support-sparrow@nic.in or sparrow.ips@nic.in.
